Building together a resilient territory

Crossed by the emblematic Verdon river, the GAL territory is recognized for its remarkable heritage, shaped by mountains, the Valensole plateau, rivers and lakes. Natural and forest areas cover respectively 79% and 60% of the territory.

Water is a true bridge within the territory: a vital resource and an economic opportunity (hydropower, tourism, agriculture). Human activities are thus well established and shape the territory: craft and farming know-how, patoralism, short supply chains, cultural heritage (Country of Art and History), a dynamic network of associations.

But it has to face several challenges: a sparsely populated area (13 inhab/km²), access to services, mobility, pressure on resources, natural risks, a more diversified economy. The LAG therefore intends to strengthen the territory's resilience and to develop its potential.

Local Development Strategy

The strategy addresses 4 types of issues:

- Developing knowledge and raising awareness through cultural and scientific action;
- Living well together in a quality environment;
- Preserving, managing and enhancing common goods in the long run;
- Supporting the shift towards a diversified, inclusive and sustainable economy.
