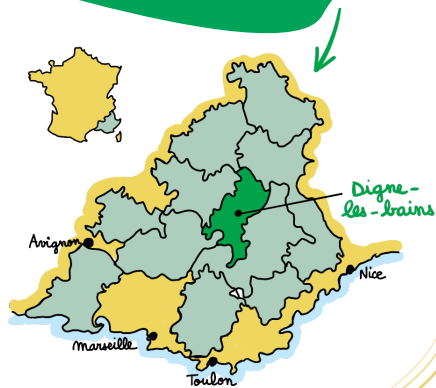

A territory dedicated to sustainable local development

Located in the heart of Provence Alpes Côte d'Azur region and organised around the prefecture town of Digne-les-Bains, the LAG's territory is a transition area between Haute Provence and Alps recognized for its remarkable natural and landscape heritage.

It is a rich and economically diversified territory with 5 functional zones : a pool of industrial and craft activities in Durance valley ; services and balneology in Dignois area ; seasonal tourism in Verdon valley ; agriculture and outdoor activities in the rural valleys of Asse and Duyes ; mountain economy based on mountain resorts and breeding in the Blanche valley.

These areas make Provence Alpes Agglomération a multifaceted territory.
